**NOTICE IN SUPPORT OF DXC’S *EX PARTE* APPLICATION FOR AN
EMERGENCY TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND
ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE RE PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION**

Per this Court’s request, Plaintiff DXC Technology Company (“DXC”) hereby provides the following additional information in support of its Complaint and Application for *Ex Parte* Temporary Restraining Order and Order to Show Cause (“TRO”) and all supporting materials.

On or about July 4, 2020, DXC first became aware of a cybersecurity-related incident that began on July 3, 2020, which appeared to be affecting certain of its computer systems. DXC did not know at that time the nature or identity of the defendants’ infrastructure being used to carry out the cyberattack.

As part of its investigation since that time, DXC has utilized numerous investigatory methods and additional software tools deployed in its systems to gather information and conduct analysis related to the cyberattack, including with respect to defendants’ infrastructure being used to carry out the attack.

On July 16, 2020, DXC had identified the domains being used by defendants in the attack on DXC's systems, which are identified in **Appendix A** to the Complaint and proposed TRO Order, and had gained enough visibility to and context about the cyberattack on its systems such that DXC was confident that the domains identified in **Appendix A** were the defendants' infrastructure being used to carry out attacks and thus needed to be disrupted to avoid further injury to DXC and its reputation, brand, and goodwill.
